



HOT POTATO FIX(TM)

THE FIXES PROGRAM | TEACHER GUIDE

START HERE

Start the passing. Forget the timer.

A fast whole-class passing game with a silent random timer, two-strike consequences and automatic survival scoring. You watch the object; the screen tracks everything else.

60-SECOND SETUP

1 ADD NAMES

Enter every player. You need at least two. Names stay loaded until the page is refreshed or closed.

2 CHOOSE THE POTATO

Use one soft classroom-safe object and establish a controlled passing direction.

3 PRESS START

Students keep the object moving. The timer is hidden and silent.

YOUR ONLY JOB WHEN THE SCREEN FLASHES HOT

TAP THE STUDENT HOLDING THE OBJECT.

The app applies Strike 1 or benches the player on Strike 2, updates survival points and prepares the next round.

EACH ROUND

1 PASS

Students keep passing. The timer secretly lasts about 3-8 seconds.

2 HOT

The screen flashes HOT and asks who is holding it.

3 TAP

Tap the holder. The app applies the consequence.

4 CONTINUE

Use Continue or Next Round. The hidden timer starts fresh.

TEACHER ROLE: WATCH THE OBJECT. TAP THE HOLDER. LET THE APP TRACK THE GAME.



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THE SCREEN REMEMBERS EVERY CONSEQUENCE

Simple statuses. Automatic scoring.

PLAYER STATUS

GREEN - ACTIVE

No strikes. Keep passing.

GOLD - STRIKE 1

Still playing, but the next HOT means benched.

PINK - BENCHED

Observes and cheers for the rest of this game.

SCORING

After each resolved round, every player who is still active or on Strike 1 earns 1 survival point. Benched players stop scoring.

HOW THE GAME ENDS

When fewer than two players remain in play, the app ends the game and names the player with the highest survival score.

BUTTONS YOU WILL SEE

CONTINUE

After a first strike.

WATCH

After a second strike.

NEXT ROUND

From the watching screen.

PLAY AGAIN

Returns to setup with the current roster still loaded in the open page.

SAFETY AND TROUBLESHOOTING

Use a soft object. Use controlled passes, never toward faces. Set the passing direction and boundaries before pressing Start. If sound is blocked, check device volume and tap once inside the page. Refreshing or closing the page removes the current roster.
